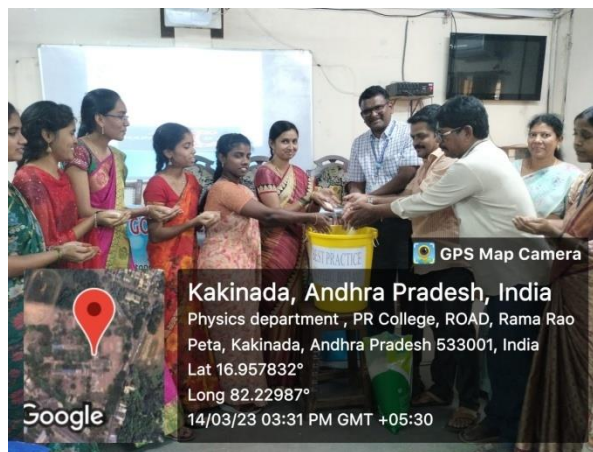
Evidence of Success:
