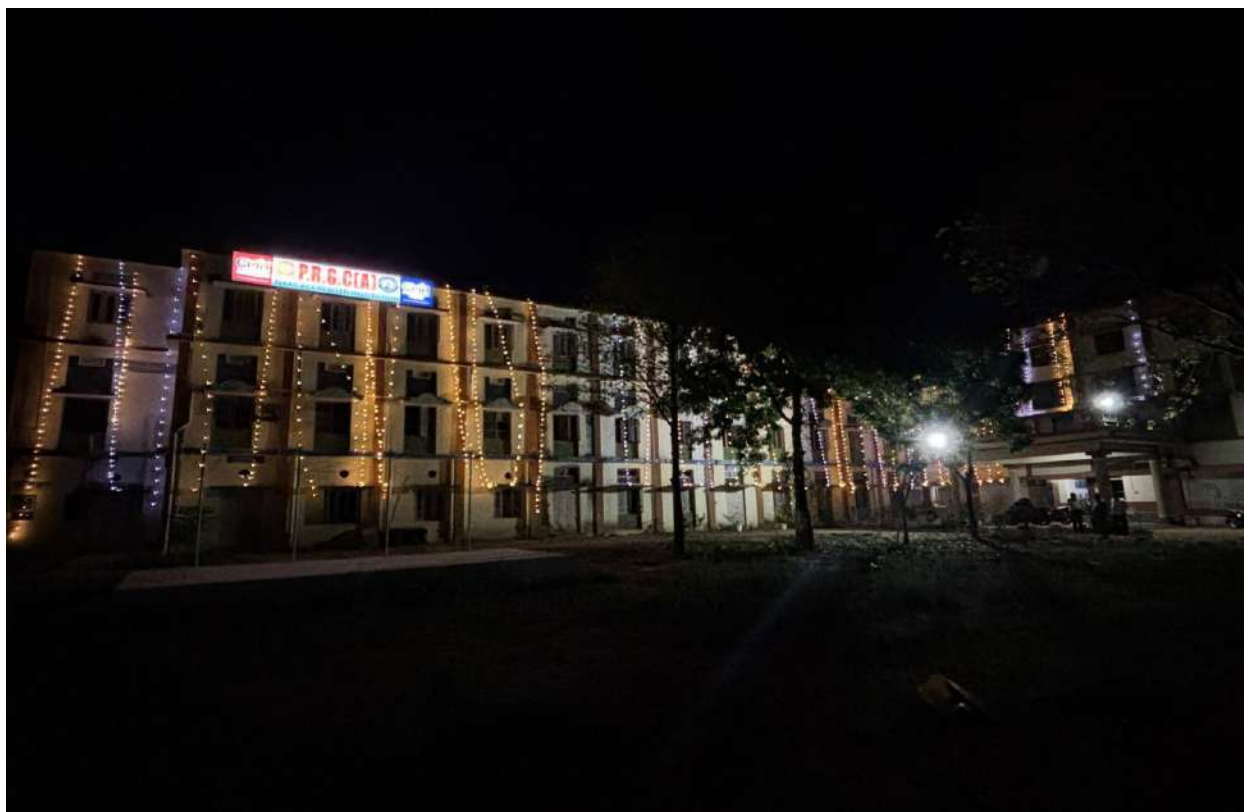

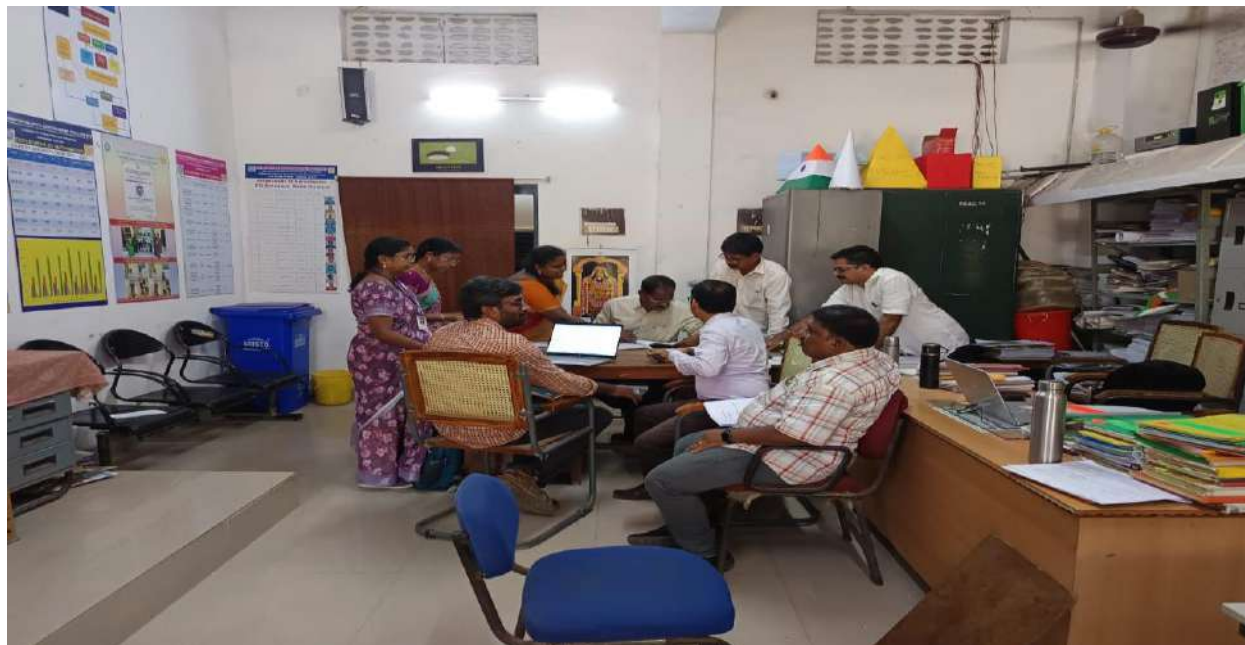
Internal Academic Audit Conducted to Strengthen Preparedness for Upcoming Academic Review (01.04.2026 to 04.04.2026)

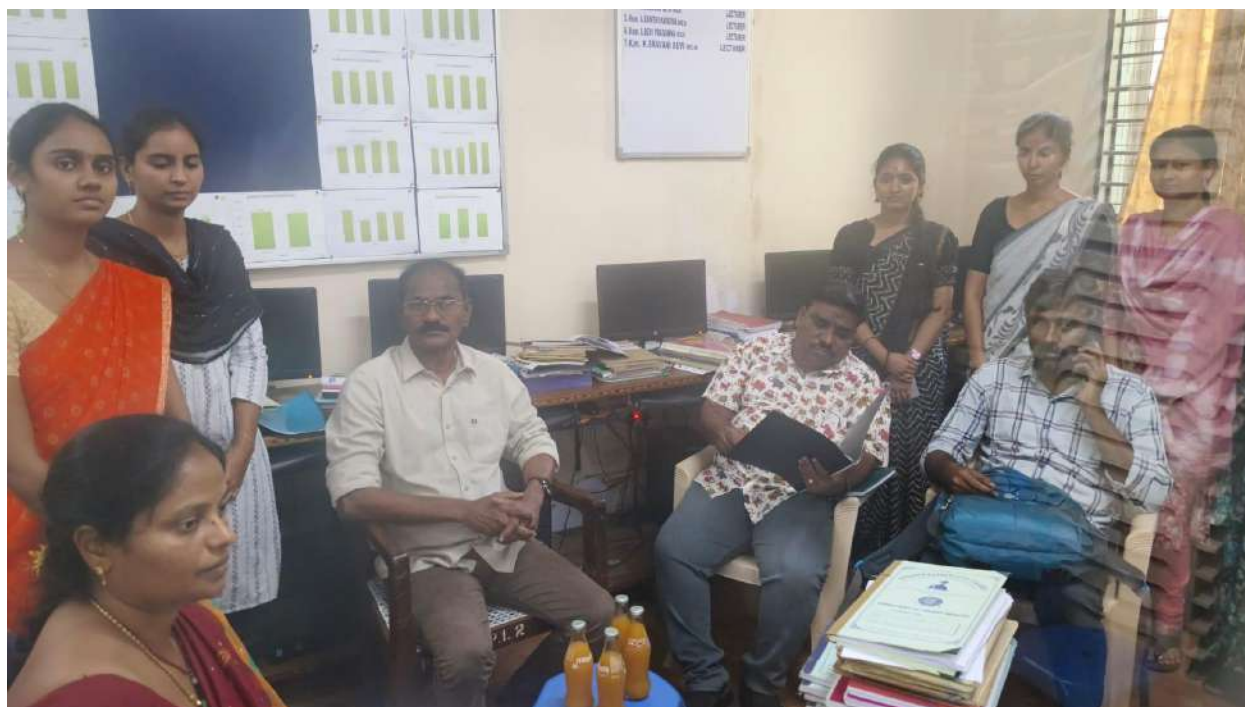

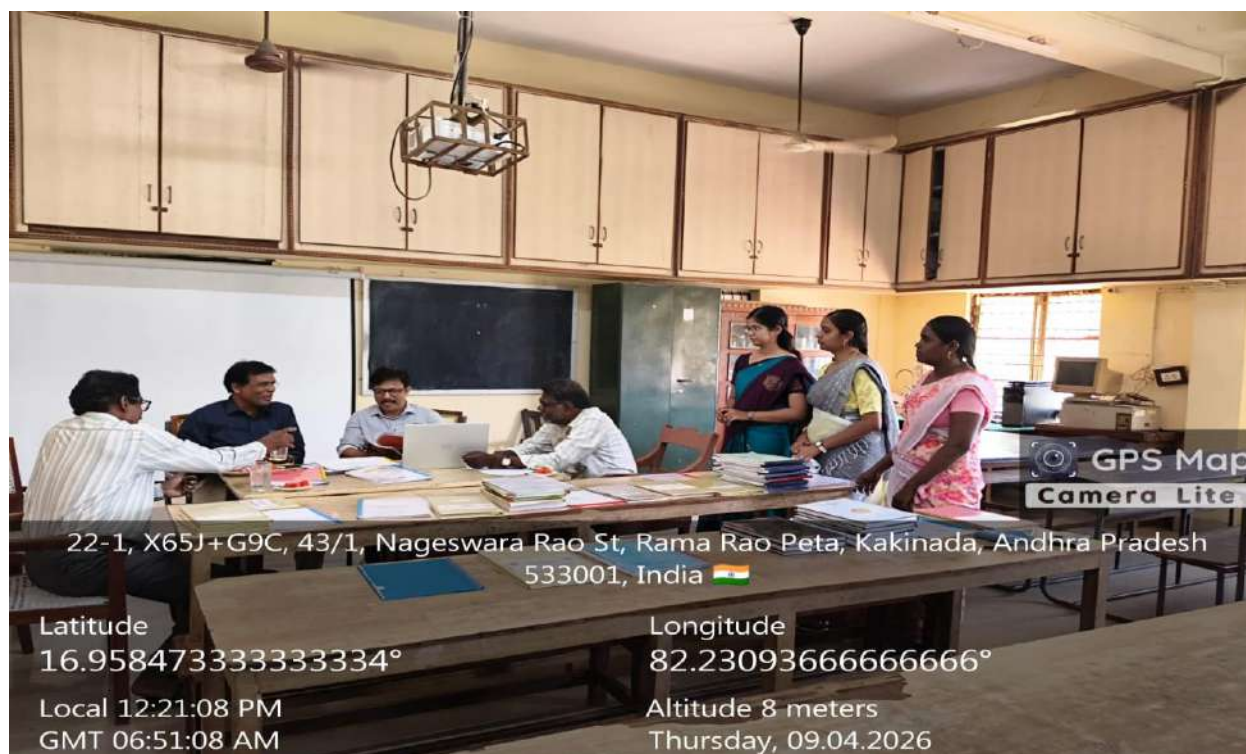

One-Day Workshop on “IPR in the age of AI” Organized by the Department of Commerce :23.04.2026

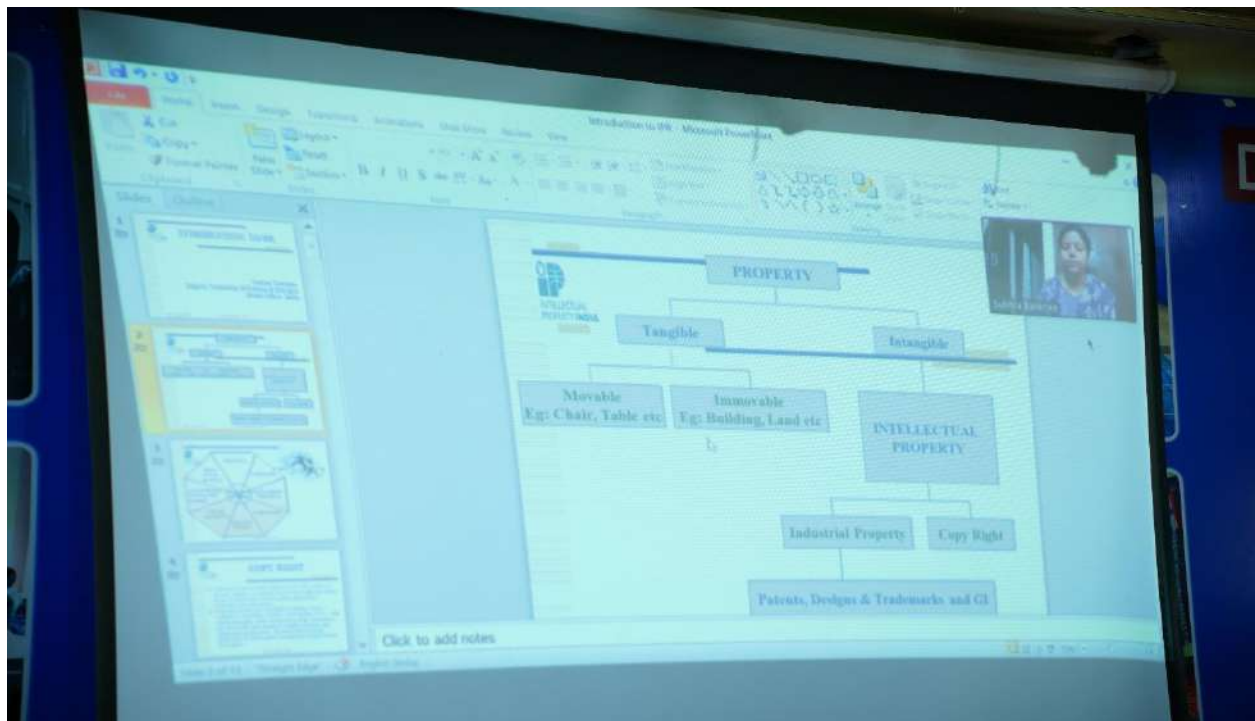

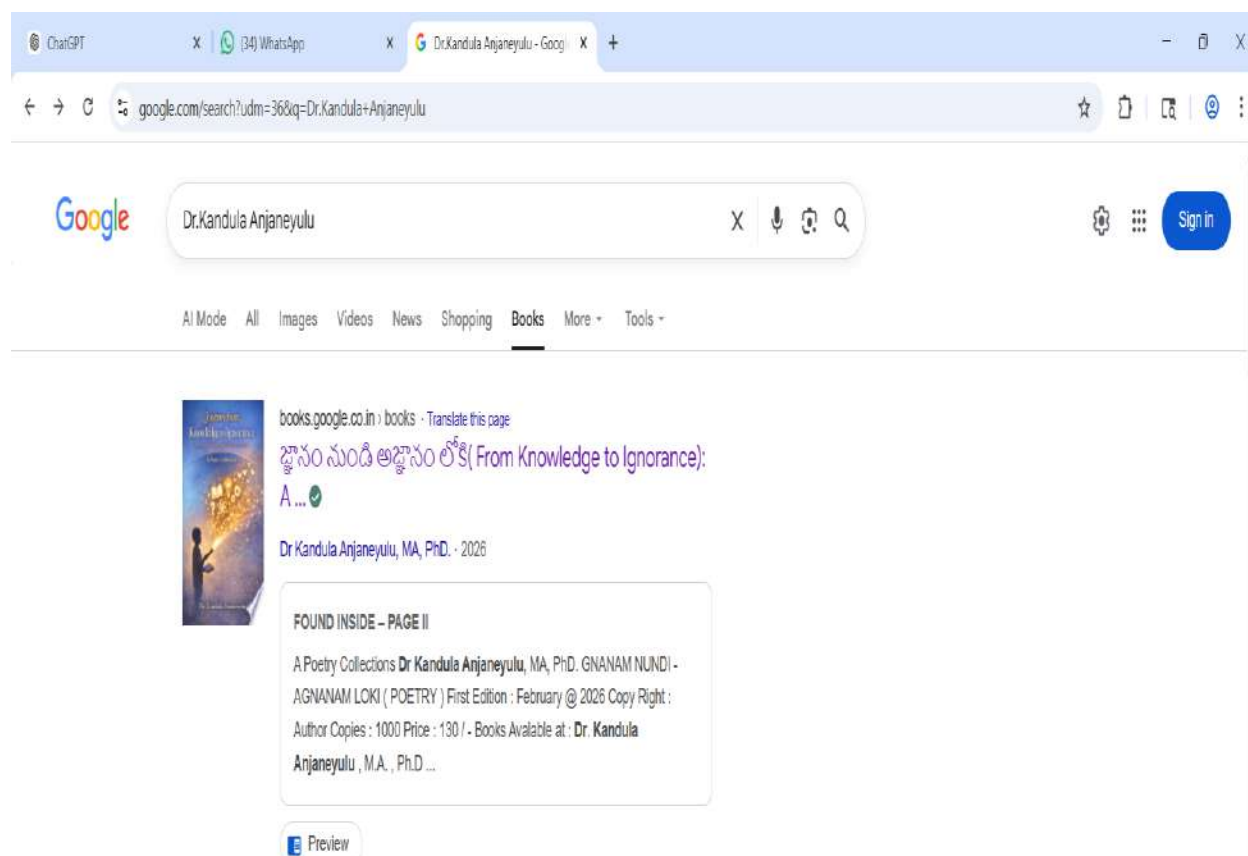

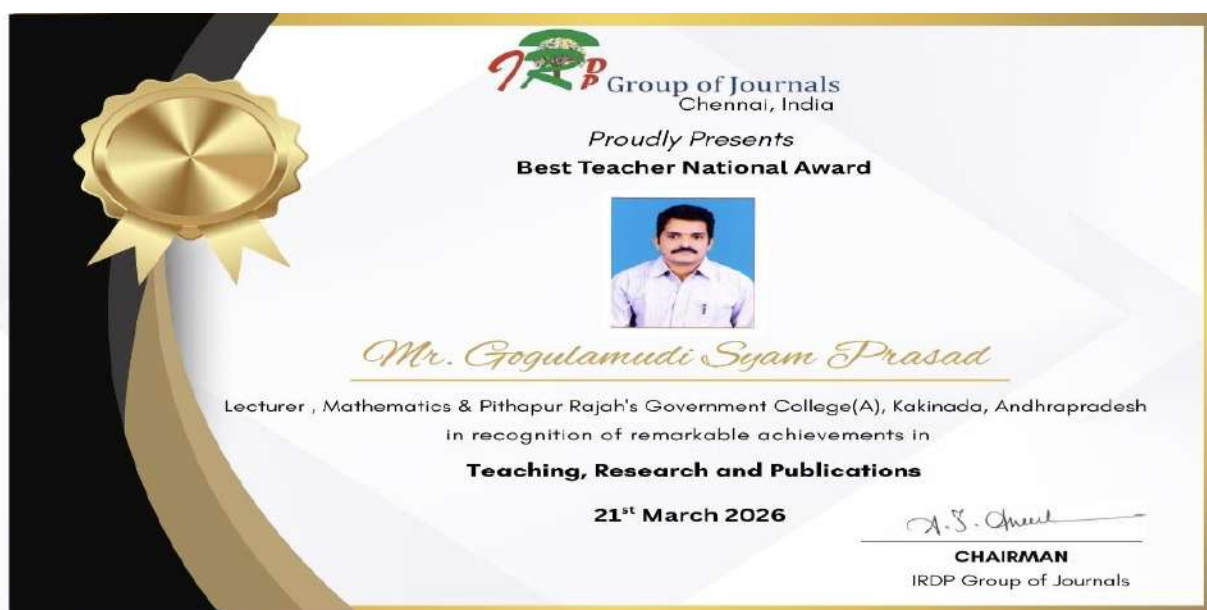

Nano-sulfonated Graphene Oxide: A Metal-free Catalyst for the Synthesis of Benzimidazoles and Antimicrobial Activities

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ABSTRACT

Nano sulfonated graphene oxide (SGO) was synthesized with slight modifications to previously reported methods. An efficient and ecofriendly protocol was developed for the synthesis of benzimidazole derivatives using *o*-phenylenediamine and D-glucose as substrates, employing a metal-free sulfonated graphene oxide carbocatalyst. A diverse range of benzimidazole derivatives was obtained in moderate to high yields (up to 94%) using a sustainable and readily available C1 source under sonication conditions. The reaction, carried out in ethanol with *tertiary*-butyl hydroperoxide, provides a general and novel approach for benzimidazole synthesis *via* a carbonylation pathway. The process is facilitated by a cost-effective and environmentally benign SGO nanocatalyst, enabling the formation of valuable products in excellent yields. The synthesized benzimidazole derivatives exhibited strong antibacterial activity, with inhibition rates of 99% to 100% against *Escherichia coli*, *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, and *Streptococcus pyogenes*.

मध्यकालीन कविता और गुरु-शिष्य परंपरा

गुरु-शिष्य परंपरा भारतीय सभ्यता की सबसे प्राचीन एवं पवित्र परंपराओं में से एक है, जो ज्ञान के मौखिक संचरण एवं आध्यात्मिक विकास का आधार रही है। यह परंपरा वेदों से लेकर उपनिषदों, महाकाव्यों एवं भक्ति काल तक निरंतर चली आ रही है। गुरु को अंधकार से प्रकाश की ओर ले जाने वाला माना गया है, जबकि शिष्य पूर्ण समर्पण एवं श्रद्धा से ज्ञान ग्रहण करता है। इस लेख में हम इस परंपरा के ऐतिहासिक, दार्शनिक एवं सांस्कृतिक महत्व को समझेंगे तथा हिंदी कवियों की रचनाओं के माध्यम से इसकी भावनात्मक गहराई को उजागर करेंगे। यह परंपरा आज भी प्रासंगिक है, क्योंकि यह व्यक्तिगत मार्गदर्शन एवं चरित्र निर्माण पर जोर देती है।

परिचय :

भारतीय संस्कृति में गुरु-शिष्य परंपरा ज्ञान की शृंखला का वह अटूट सूत्र है। 'गुरु' शब्द की व्युत्पत्ति 'गु' (अंधकार) और 'रु' (प्रकाश) से हुई है, अर्थात् अज्ञान के अंधकार को दूर करने वाला। उपनिषदों में 'उपनिषद्' का अर्थ ही है गुरु के निकट बैठकर ज्ञान प्राप्त करना। यह परंपरा हिंदू, जैन, बौद्ध एवं सिख धर्मों में समान रूप से विद्यमान है। प्राचीन काल में शिक्षा गुरुकुल प्रणाली के माध्यम से होती थी, जहां शिष्य गुरु के आश्रम में रहकर परिवार के सदस्य की भांति जीवन व्यतीत करते थे। गुरु केवल पुस्तकीय ज्ञान नहीं देते थे, बल्कि जीवन मूल्यों, नैतिकता, योग, संगीत, युद्धकला एवं आध्यात्मिक साधना का भी प्रशिक्षण देते थे। यह परंपरा मौखिक थी, जिससे ज्ञान में कोई विकृति नहीं आती थी।

ऐतिहासिक एवं दार्शनिक पृष्ठभूमि :

वैदिक काल से ही गुरु-शिष्य परंपरा का प्रारंभ हुआ। वेदों का ज्ञान गुरु-मुख से शिष्य तक पहुंचता था। मुंडक उपनिषद् में कहा गया है कि ब्रह्मविद्या प्राप्ति के लिए गुरु की शरण लेनी चाहिए। रामायण में राम-हनुमान का संबंध भक्ति का सर्वोत्तम उदाहरण है। हनुमान जी राम के परम भक्त एवं शिष्य हैं, जो गुरु की आज्ञा से सब कुछ त्यागने को तैयार हैं। महाभारत में कृष्ण-अर्जुन का संबंध अद्वयन है। भगवद्गीता में कृष्ण अर्जुन को आध्यात्मिक गुरु के रूप में मार्गदर्शन देते हैं।

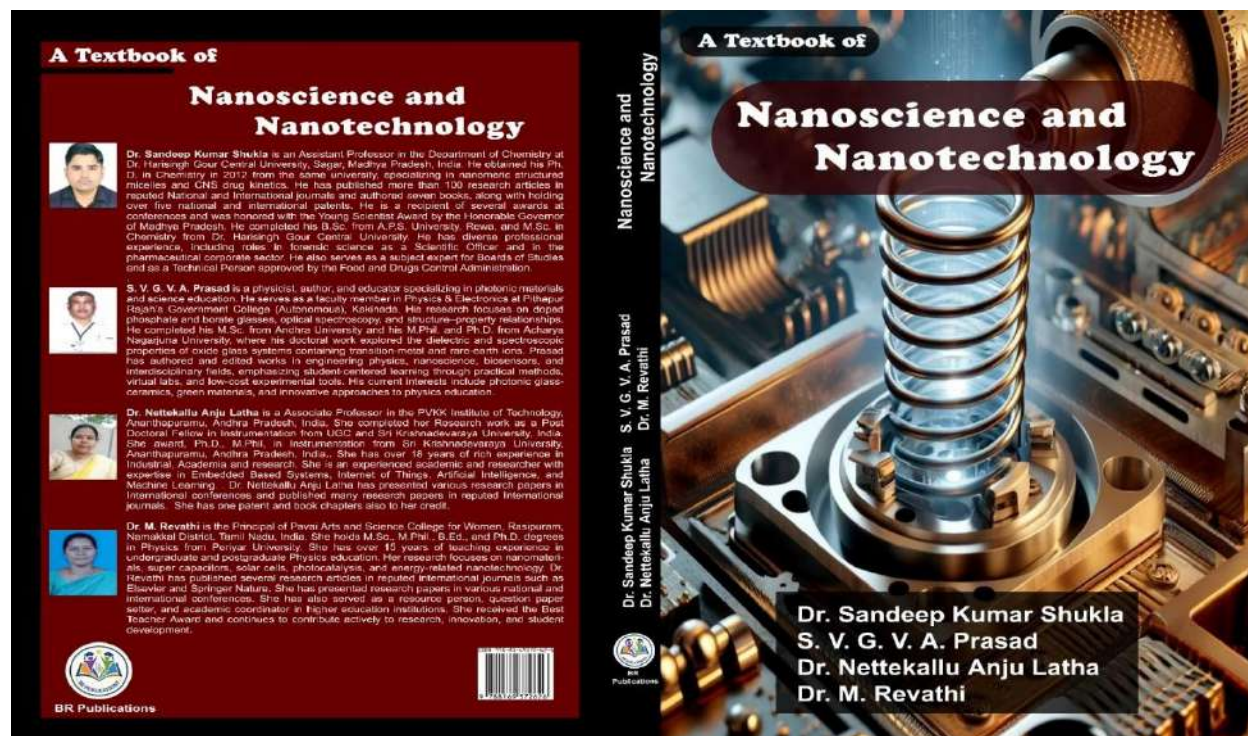
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
