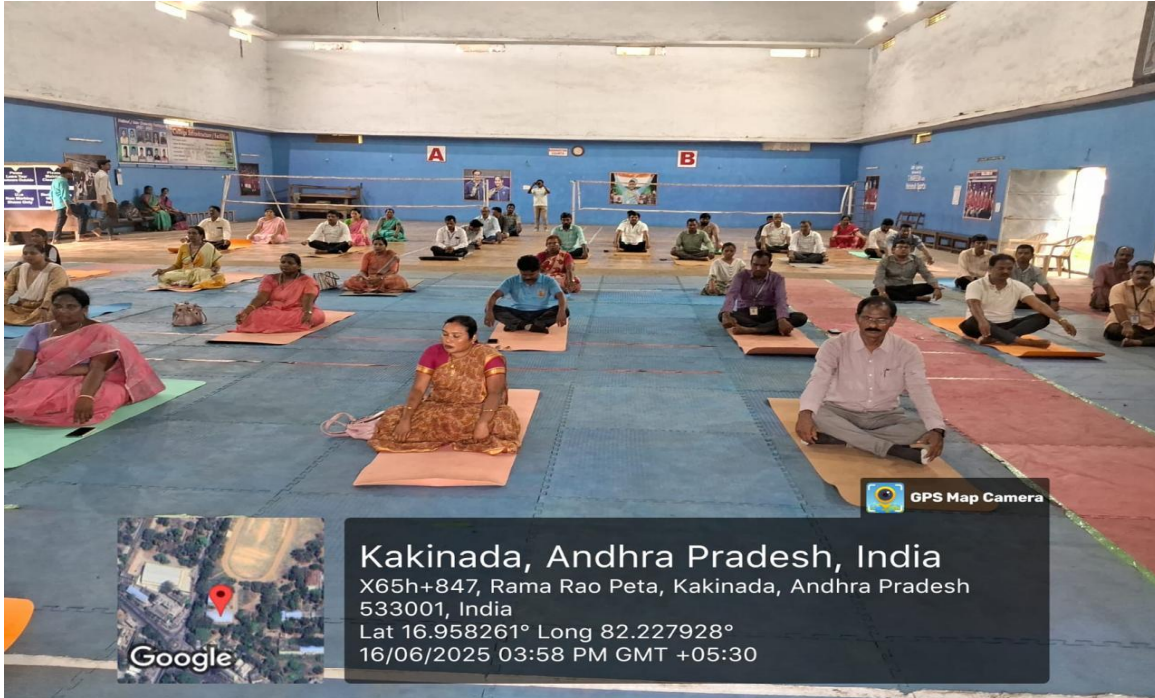
PROGRAM:

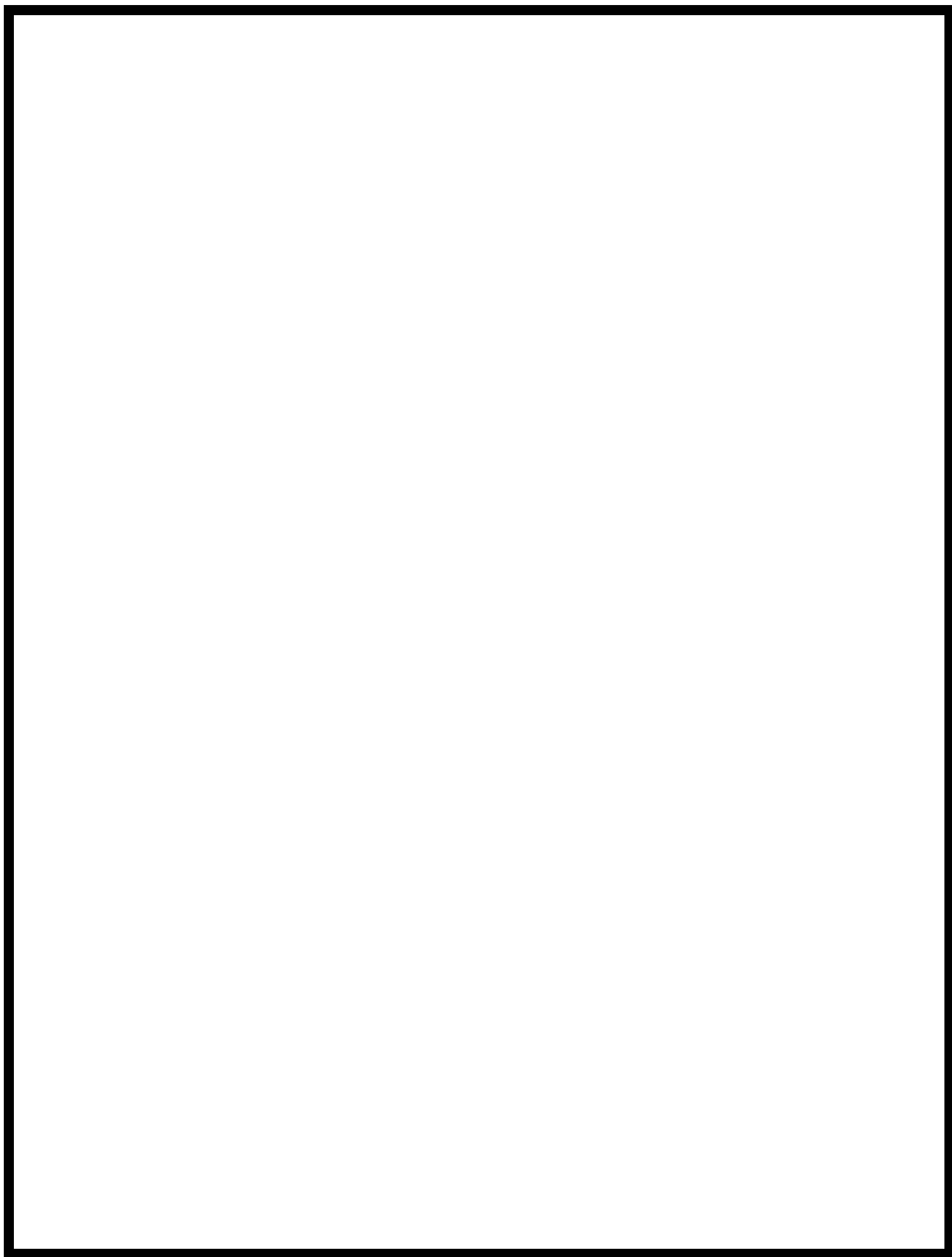

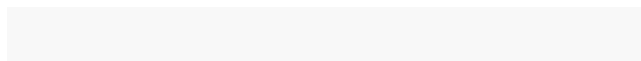

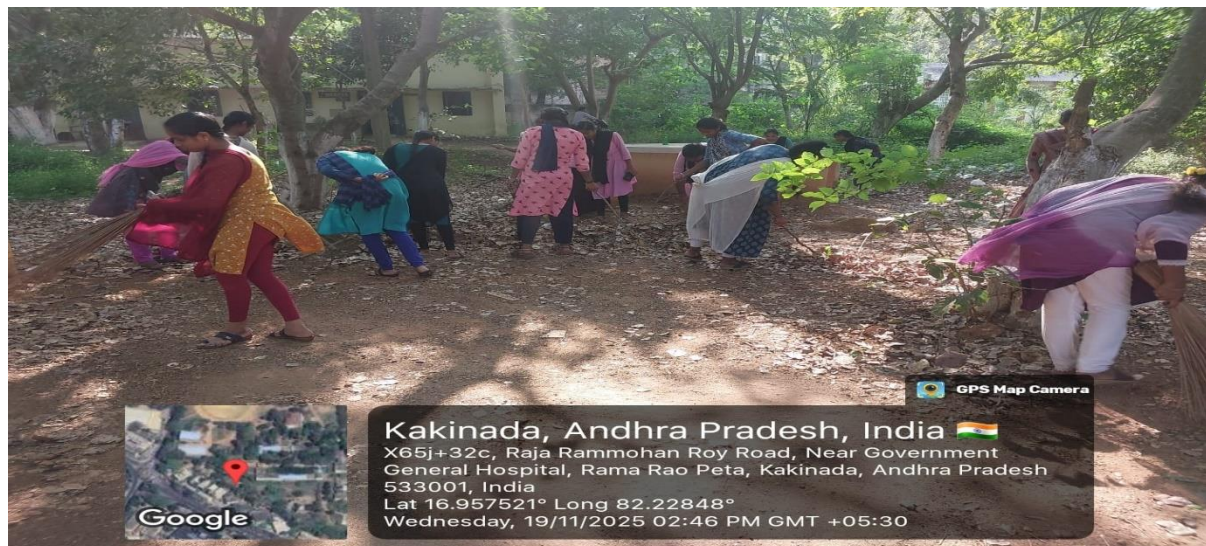

- Gained practical experience in community service

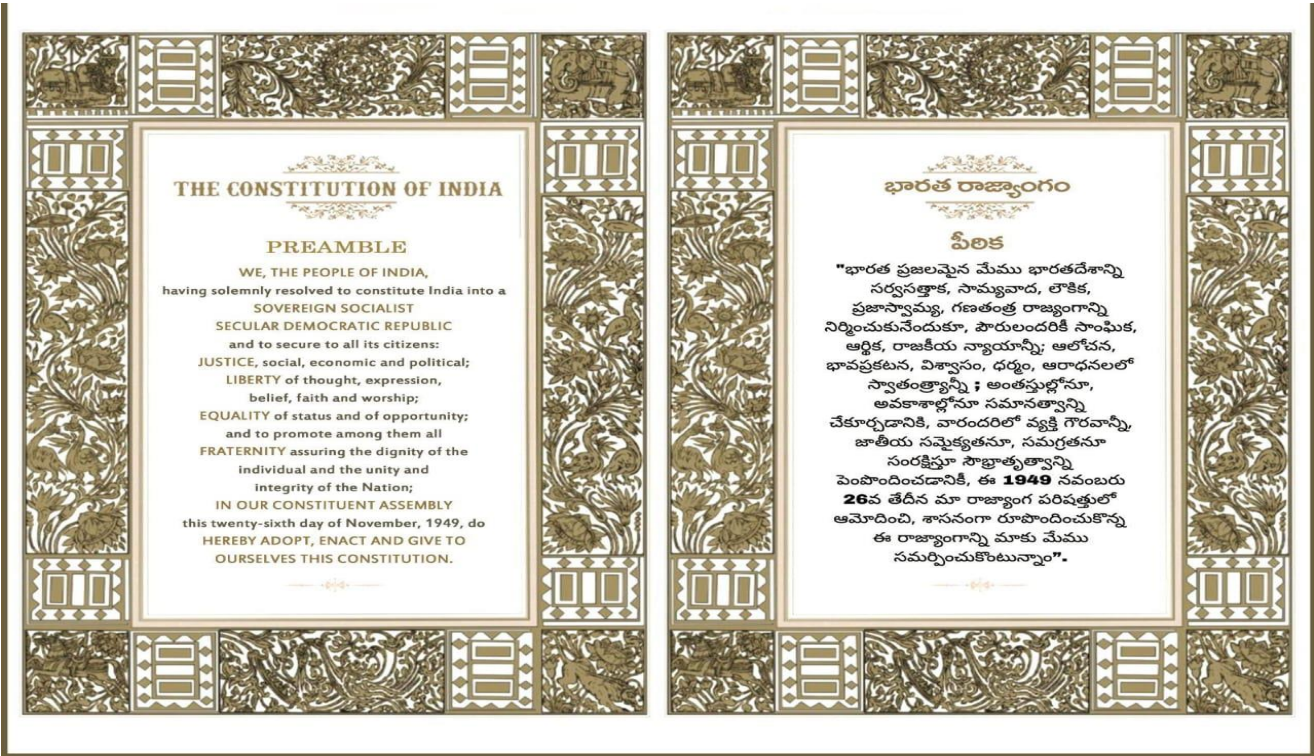
Conclusion

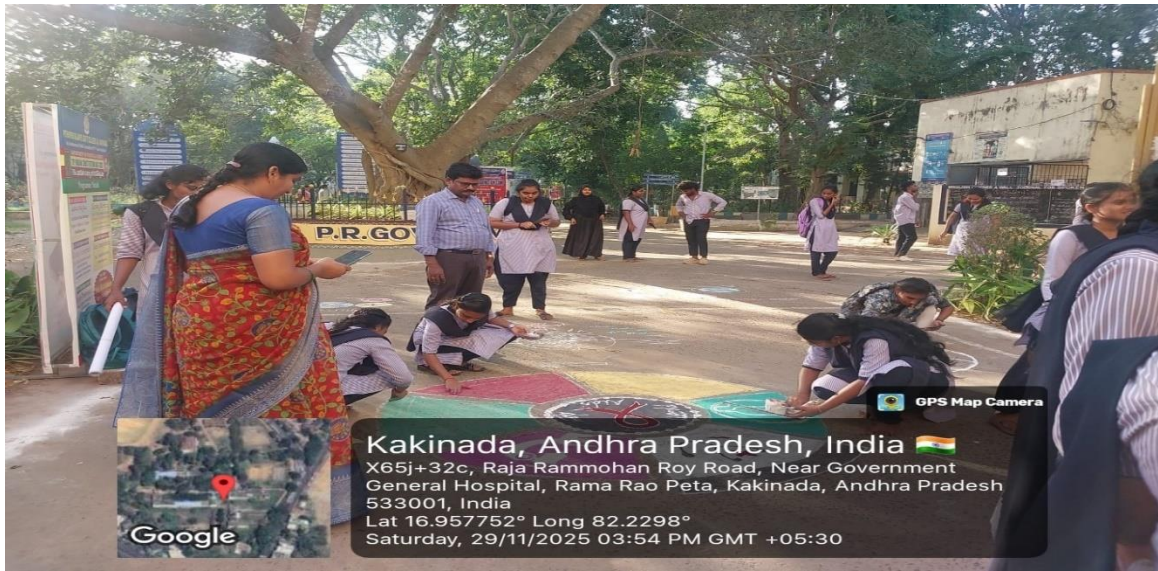

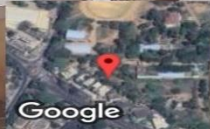
